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## *Vintage Notes*

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### PETIT VERDOT 2014

This Petit Verdot is a 100% varietal wine with a striking dark purple color in the glass. Bright red fruit aromas intermingle with a hint of subtle cedar and currant accents on the nose. The palate is structured with strong tannins that lead the way to a juicy middle and a finish that is memorably bright and lingering. This wine was aged entirely in new French oak and given plenty of time in bottle which contributes to its layers and grace.

The grapes for all Jarvis wines are grown on hillside vineyards, which were originally planted in 1986. The winery and vineyards are located on the Vaca Mountain, about 1,000 feet above the valley floor and four miles east of the city of Napa. The cool mountain growing region provides moderate temperatures for optimum ripening of the grapes.
